Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat is one of the most prized and prestigious residential locations in the world.

In the 1930s, Jacques Menier, World War I fighter pilot and heir to the Menier chocolate empire, purchased the land neighboring with an eye to building a luxurious villa to enjoy the location's sunny climate and ocean views. He hired architect Ernest Viggio of Nice, who finished the property in 1932. The Menier family retained the property until the late 1950s.

The next owner was German-Austrian actor Curd Jürgens, who is best-known for his roles as the villain in many spy movies, including the James Bond classic The Spy Who Loved Me. In 1966, the Rizzoli publishing family from Milan bought the property. In 1975, they hired the Italian architect Luigi Vietti to modify the property to showcase its Mediterranean setting with a uniquely natural style. Vietti became very well-known for his approach, which promoted harmony between architecture and nature.
